## *What is Water System Asset Management?*

Asset management is a framework that helps water systems make informed decisions about the management of their water infrastructure. Going through an asset management process gives systems a documented understanding of the assets they have, how long they are going to last, and how much it's going to cost to repair, rehabilitate or replace them. The main asset management practices include:

- Building an inventory of assets,
- Scheduling and tracking maintenance tasks through work orders, and
- Managing budgeted and actual annual expenses and revenue.

## *How does CUPSS fit into Asset Management?*

The Check Up Program for Small Systems (CUPSS), first released in 2008, is a desktop software that smaller water and wastewater systems can use to implement their asset management practices.
